Unit Level Single Event (Meetings, Day Only Activity)

Minimum COVID protocol

As statistics for COVID-19 continue to improve and operations in California reopen, the Golden Gate Area Council (GGAC) presents the minimum requirements to conduct Scouting activities in-person. These requirements will not prevent COVID-19 from occurring but are designed to minimize exposure and spread. Ultimately, the choice to participate in In-person scouting activities lies with each scouting family.

Single Events (Meetings, Day Only Activities)

- The BSA [Safe Restart Checklist](#) must be followed. Unit Chartered Organizations must approve of the unit or any of its Scouts participation in an activity.
- Each participant – including all siblings and family members must complete the [COVID-19 Pre Activity/ Event/ Meeting Checklist](#)
- Review the [GGAC COVID Page](#) to determine the tier assignment of your home county **AND** your destination county to determine what activities are allowed.
- Face Coverings must be worn anytime a person is within three feet of anyone they do not reside with.
- A designated handwashing or sanitizing station is available/ marked.
- If food is present, it must be served individually wrapped or in groups no larger than for individual families.
